Greetings! Our Honduran non-profit partner, FECOVESO, continues to be very busy! This year, in addition to the usual appreciation from communities and municipalities for their excellent work, FECOVESO was presented with a handsome plaque noting their contributions to the environment and their communities.





The interminable rains in Honduras this year caused huge flooding and mudslide damage. This added to the need to replace and repair the 30-year old water system built by Camino Nuevo and San Miguelito. It was the second system I worked on as a Peace Corps volunteer in the I990s (pre-HCSC!) The purchase of their watershed in 2001 was the first of many watersheds preserved and protected by HCSC and its communities in its 22 years of work in Honduras.



Individual school desks (like the ones pictured on the left, ready to go up the mountain), are in great demand to replace crowded long tables with benches. FECOVESO is also helping to fill the gaps in school supplies.



My broken hip and Kirby's almost non-functioning legs have kept us home another year - very disappointing! I do get to attend some of FECOVESO's regular meetings via internet. Their careful consideration of the projects that communities have identified as most pressing - watershed acquisition, water system repairs, materials for bridges and protective fencing, construction and repair of health centers and schools and more - and the satisfaction and pride they feel in being able to meet those needs is visible and inspiring!
